Welcome to our brand-new Nursery. This was previously our Yr1 and Yr2 classrooms. An incredible learning space for our very youngest children.



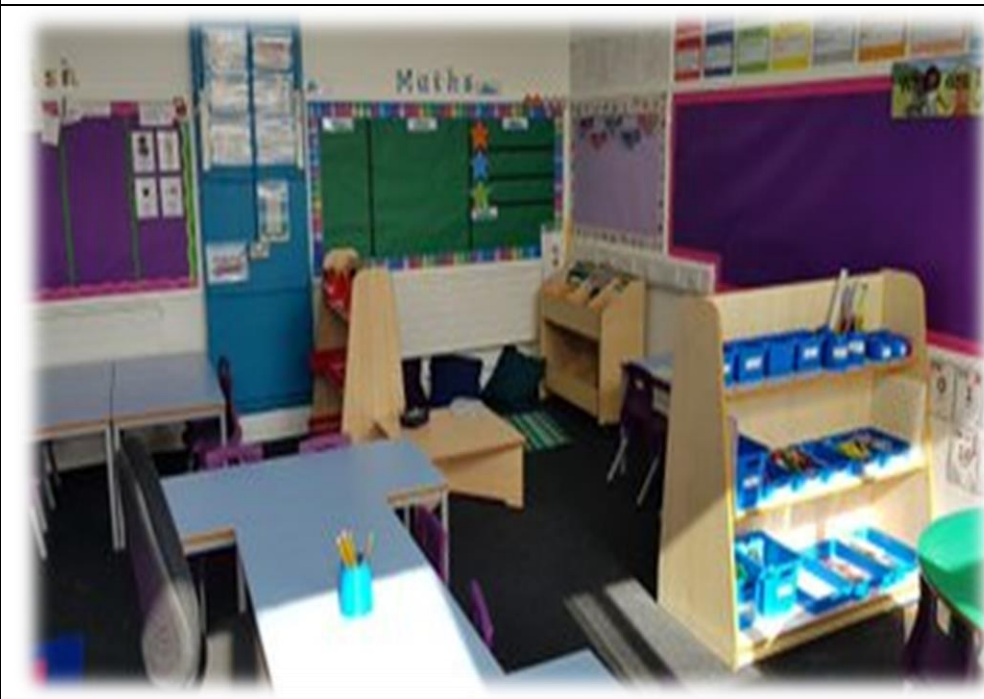

Welcome to our wonderful new Yr5 classroom, for the Autumn term. This was previously our Yr4 classroom. A stunning new learning space for our older children, where we know great things will be achieved.





Welcome to our beautiful Year Six classroom. This is the same classroom as last year, but we've had new blinds, carpets, plastering, painting, sinks, etc. Yr6 will move into the new extension in 2021. A great space for children to work hard and achieve great things, in their final year at Mayfield.





Our Maths Hub room has been transformed and is now ready for our oldest children. Sky lights have also been added. Yr6 love the boardroom style tables. A very sophisticated learning environment!





The Dining Room is ready to use once again. Hoardings are in place to separate the current Dining Room and the new extension, which will be completed by November.
